This is one of Adolf Loos' (who was born in Brno) last *Raumplan* villas, of the same period as Villa Müller (also in Prague), and therefore one of the most advanced versions of this design. Villa Müller is closed for repairs from 1st February 2025 and probably until February 2026, and tours in Villa Winternitz are normally only offered in Czech. Karel has specifically arranged for the tour to be offered to our group in English!
